GATE CITY, NC – The cows weren't the only ones seeing stars last Thursday when local soybean farmer *Elroy J. Spangler*, 62, claims he was *beamed aboard a glowing saucer* and probed by a swarm of "six-eyed bee-alien hybrids" that communicated through *smell and telepathic yodeling*.
